

## PHA HIGH POWER MATCH RESULTS 25 June 2022

Our June match was held on 25 June and we had great weather, even though it did get a little warm as the morning ended. We were finished by around 1100 and had everything put up.

We discussed the possibility of letting competitors shoot either a 500 or an 800 aggregate course for our next match and see how it works for us logistically and time wise. The competitor would choose prior to the start of the match if they want to shoot 50 or 80 rds. They would then fire 10 or 20 rds in the standing SF, sitting RF, and prone RF stages. Everyone would fire the required 20 rds for the prone SF final stage. Scoring would be held at the end of the second string of each stage, so it would only entail an extra 10 min for the standing stage and a couple of minutes prep time and 60 or 70 seconds for the RF stages. After discussion, it was agreed to try it and see how it goes. I had talked to the NRA HP representative and she said it was allowable, so hopefully it'll work out for all competitors.

Congratulations to Jeff Minder, our tournament winner shooting a 481-6. Stephen Tate was second by "X" count with a 479-12 and Travis Rushing third with a 479-9.

Ben brought an AR for his second match and left his M1 at home. We had 2 young ladies come out to observe and said they were interested in possibly competing with us. They are members of their middle school shooting team and their team won a lot of trophies this past year.

Wayne and I discussed the possibility of having a new shooters High Power clinic at PHA, either after our July match or possibly on a Saturday prior to or after that match. If anyone on our competitor list has a friend or knows of someone that might be interested, let us know. This would be for juniors and adults as well. We have some equipment for use if someone doesn't have any, but would like to try out High Power shooting.

Our next match will be Sat, 23 July.

Thank you to all competitors for set up, break down, and helping to run a smooth match.
